## The Center for Watershed Protection is growing up!

Healthy organizations grow and prosper, and due to the Center's continuing relevance and regard, we are facing a major move to more accommodating, more professional, and greener space within the coming year.

We estimate that our move will cost about \$120,000. With a move to larger quarters, we hope to **add to the services the Center provides**, including establishing a library of watershed and stormwater resources, developing an electronic database of resources, and providing space for the growing number of staff -- space that has fewer bugs and ceiling drips (that's where the "more professional" part comes in).

## Please consider making a special donation to our moving fund this year.
